31	information related to COVID-19 testing and vaccination be

37	sites based on aggregate data, and will ensure that testing and

43	Section 1. COVID-19 daily data reporting
44	(1) The Department of Health shall issue daily reports on
45	its website which include, at a minimum, aggregate testing and
46	vaccination data at the county level in one chart, including the
47	birth year, sex, race, ethnicity, and county of each individual
48	who is tested or vaccinated.
49	(2) The reports under subsection (1) are public records
50	subject to s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and shall be made
51	available upon request in accordance with that section.
52	(3) Nothing in this section may be construed to authorize
53	the release or publication of personal identifying information,
54	biometric identification information, or other personal health
55	information protected under state or federal law.
56	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
