House Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 4 of Article IX and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution to prohibit compensation for members of a district school board.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the following amendment to Section 4 of Article IX and the creation of a new section in Article XII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE IX EDUCATION

SECTION 4. School districts; school boards.-

- (a) Each county shall constitute a school district; provided, two or more contiguous counties, upon vote of the electors of each county pursuant to law, may be combined into one school district. In each school district there shall be a school board composed of five or more members chosen by vote of the electors in a nonpartisan election for appropriately staggered terms of four years, as provided by law.
 - (b) The school board shall operate, control and supervise

all free public schools within the school district and determine the rate of school district taxes within the limits prescribed herein. Two or more school districts may operate and finance joint educational programs. Members of a school board shall serve without compensation.

ARTICLE XII

SCHEDULE

Prohibition on compensation for members of a district school board.—This section and the amendment to Section 4 of Article IX prohibiting compensation for members of a district school board shall take effect upon approval by the electors and apply to newly elected members of a district school board elected on or after November 8, 2022, and to members of a district school board reelected on or after November 8, 2022, with at least eight years of service after November 8, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:
