An act relating to seagrass mitigation banks; amending s. 253.03, F.S.; authorizing the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund to authorize leases for seagrass mitigation banks under certain conditions; providing construction; requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to modify specified mitigation banking rules for specified purposes; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (17) is added to section 253.03, Florida Statutes, to read:

253.03 Board of trustees to administer state lands; lands enumerated.—

(17) The board of trustees may authorize leases for seagrass mitigation banks under s. 373.4136 to ensure the preservation and regeneration of seagrass, as defined in s. 253.04(3)(a), and to offset the unavoidable impacts of projects when seagrass banks meet the public interest criteria under chapters 253 and 258. This subsection does not prohibit mitigation for impacts to seagrass or other habitats on sovereignty submerged lands, upon approval of the board of trustees.

Section 2. The Department of Environmental Protection shall modify rules adopted pursuant to s. 373.4136, Florida Statutes, to remove any duplicative financial assurance requirements and to ensure that permitted seagrass mitigation banks comply with
