A bill to be entitled

An act relating to determining restitution amounts for crimes; amending s. 775.089, F.S.; revising the standards and evidence to be used in determining restitution amounts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) of section 775.089, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

775.089 Restitution.-

(7) Any dispute as to the proper amount or type of restitution shall be resolved by the court by the preponderance of the evidence. The court is not bound by fair market value as the sole standard for determining restitution amounts, but rather, may exercise such discretion as required to further the purposes of restitution, including consideration of hearsay. The burden of demonstrating the amount of the loss sustained by a victim as a result of the offense is on the state attorney. The burden of demonstrating the present financial resources and the absence of potential future financial resources of the defendant and the financial needs of the defendant and his or her dependents is on the defendant. The burden of demonstrating such other matters as the court deems appropriate is upon the party designated by the court as justice requires.
