A bill to be entitled

An act relating to marriage equality; repealing s. 741.212, F.S., relating to marriages between persons of the same sex; removing a prohibition on the recognition of marriages entered into between persons of the same sex in this state, another state, or another jurisdiction, either domestic or foreign; removing a prohibition on giving effect to any public act, record, or judicial proceeding of another jurisdiction respecting a marriage or relationship not recognized in this state or a claim arising from such a marriage or relationship; removing the definition of the term "marriage," which limits marriage only to a legal union between one man and one woman; providing a directive to the Division of Law Revision; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 741.212, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 2. The Division of Law Revision is directed to prepare a reviser's bill for the 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature to change the terms "husband" and "wife" to "spouse," the term "husband and wife" to "spouses," and the term "husband or wife" to "either spouse" wherever those terms appear in the Florida Statutes.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
