An agency that is the custodian of the information 16 3. 17 specified in subparagraph 2. and that is not the employer of the 18 officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in 19 subparagraph 2. shall maintain the exempt status of that 20 information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other 21 person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a 22 written request for maintenance of the exemption to the 23 custodial agency.

24 An officer, an employee, a justice, a judge, or other 4. 25 person specified in subparagraph 2. may submit a written request for the release of his or her exempt information to the 26 27 custodial agency. The written request must be notarized and must specify the information to be released and the party that is 28 29 authorized to receive the information.
