21	(2) (a) In an effort to serve the state's significant
22	interest in protecting the well-being, tranquility, and privacy
23	of the home and protecting residents from the detrimental effect
24	of targeted picketing, it is unlawful for a person or persons to
25	picket or protest before or about the residence or dwelling of
26	any person with the intent to harass or disturb that person in
