7 (5) (a) Each Florida College System institution and state
 8 university shall post prominently in the course registration
 9 system and on its website, ~~as early as is feasible, but at least~~
 10 ~~45 days before the first day of class for each term,~~ a hyperlink
 11 to lists of required and recommended textbooks and instructional
 12 materials ~~for at least 95 percent of all courses and course~~
 13 ~~sections~~ offered at the institution during the upcoming term.
 14 The lists must include the International Standard Book Number
 15 (ISBN) for each required and recommended textbook and
 16 instructional material or other identifying information, which

17 must include, at a minimum, all of the following: the title, all
18 authors listed, publishers, edition number, copyright date,
19 published date, and other relevant information necessary to
20 identify the specific textbooks or instructional materials
21 required and recommended for each course. The State Board of
22 Education and the Board of Governors shall include in the
23 policies, procedures, and guidelines adopted under subsection
24 (6) certain limited exceptions to this notification requirement
25 for classes added after the notification deadline.

26 (b) The lists of required and recommended textbooks and
27 instructional materials required in paragraph (a) must:

28 1. Be posted as early as is feasible, but at least 45 days
29 before the first day of class for each term, for at least 95
30 percent of all courses and course sections offered at the
31 institution during the upcoming term.

32 2. Remain posted for at least 4 academic years.

33 3. Be searchable by academic term, department, course
34 number, course section, the name of the instructor of the
35 course, and International Standard Book Number (ISBN).

36 4. Be easily printed or downloadable by current and
37 prospective students for their registered courses or search
38 results.

39 (c) Beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year for general
40 education core course options identified pursuant to s. 1007.25,
41 and by the 2024-2025 academic year for all upper-level courses

42 required as part of a degree program, course syllabi containing
43 sufficient detail to inform students of all of the following
44 must be included in the course registration system and remain
45 posted for at least 4 academic years:

46 1. The course curriculum.

47 2. The goals, objectives, and student expectations of the
48 course.

49 3. How student performance will be measured.

50 (7) The board of trustees of each Florida College System
51 institution and state university shall report, by September 30
52 of each year, to the Chancellor of the Florida College System or
53 the Chancellor of the State University System, as applicable,
54 the textbook and instructional materials selection process for
55 high-enrollment courses; specific initiatives of the institution
56 designed to reduce the costs of textbooks and instructional
57 materials; policies implemented in accordance with subsection
58 (5); the number of courses and course sections that were not
59 able to meet the textbook and instructional materials and course
60 syllabi posting deadline for the previous academic year; and any
61 additional information determined by the chancellors. By
62 November 1 of each year, each chancellor shall provide a summary
63 of the information provided by institutions to the State Board
64 of Education and the Board of Governors, as applicable.
