4 Between lines 540 and 541, insert:

5 Section 4. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section
6 1009.52, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

7 1009.52 Florida Postsecondary Student Assistance Grant
8 Program; eligibility for grants.—

9 (2) Florida postsecondary student assistance grants may be
10 made to students who meet the general requirements for student
11 eligibility as provided in s. 1009.40, except as otherwise
12 provided in this section. Such grants shall be awarded for the
13 amount of demonstrated unmet need for tuition and fees and may

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14 not exceed the maximum annual award amount specified in the
15 General Appropriations Act. A demonstrated unmet need of less
16 than \$200 shall render the applicant ineligible for a Florida
17 postsecondary student assistance grant.

18 (b) Awards may be made to full-time certificate-seeking
19 students who have been accepted at an aviation maintenance
20 school that is located in this state, certified by the Federal
21 Aviation Administration, and licensed by the Commission for
22 Independent Education, regardless of the number of clock hours
23 required by the school's curriculum. Such student's eligibility
24 for the renewal of an award shall be evaluated at the end of the
25 completion of 900 clock hours, and, as a condition of renewal,
26 the student shall meet the requirements under s. 1009.40(1)(b).
