7 (d) A charter may be modified during its initial term or
 8 any renewal term upon the recommendation of the sponsor or the
 9 charter school's governing board and the approval of both
 10 parties to the agreement. Changes to curriculum which are
 11 consistent with state standards shall be deemed approved unless
 12 the sponsor and the Department of Education determine in writing
 13 that the curriculum is inconsistent with state standards.
 14 Modification during any term may include, but is not limited to,
 15 consolidation of multiple charters into a single charter if the
 16 charters are operated under the same governing board, regardless

17 of the renewal cycle. A charter school in a municipality may
18 assign its charter, at the end of the school year, to a charter
19 school operator that meets the requirements of paragraph (12) (i)
20 and operates high-performing charter schools within the same
21 school district. A charter school that is not subject to a
22 school improvement plan and that closes as part of a
23 consolidation shall be reported by the sponsor as a
24 consolidation.
