year period to a 10-year period. The fee for such replacement is 27 \$28, \$2.80 of which shall be paid each year before the plate is 28 replaced, to be credited toward the next \$28 replacement fee. The fees shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating 29 30 Trust Fund. A credit or refund may not be given for any prior years' payments of the prorated replacement fee if the plate is 31 32 replaced or surrendered before the end of the 10-year period, except that a credit may be given if a registrant is required by 33 34 the department to replace a license plate under s. 320.08056(8)(a). With each license plate, a validation sticker 35 36 shall be issued showing the owner's birth month, license plate number, and the year of expiration or the appropriate renewal 37 38 period if the owner is not a natural person. The validation 39 sticker shall be placed on the upper right corner of the license plate. The license plate and validation sticker shall be issued 40 41 based on the applicant's appropriate renewal period. The 42 registration period is 12 months, the extended registration 43 period is 24 months, and all expirations occur based on the 44 applicant's appropriate registration period. Rental vehicles 45 taxed pursuant to s. 320.08(6)(a) may elect a permanent 46 registration period, provided payment of the appropriate license 47 taxes and fees occurs annually.

48 2. A vehicle that has an apportioned registration shall be 49 issued an annual license plate and a cab card that denote the declared gross vehicle weight for each apportioned jurisdiction 50

51 in which the vehicle is authorized to operate. This subparagraph 52 expires June 30, 2024. 53 3. Beginning July 1, 2024, a vehicle registered in 54 accordance with the International Registration Plan must be 55 issued a license plate for a 3-year period. At the end of the 3-56 year period, upon renewal, the license plate must be replaced. 57 Each license plate must include a validation sticker showing the month of expiration. A cab card denoting the declared gross 58 59 vehicle weight for each apportioned jurisdiction must be issued annually. The fee for an original or a renewal cab card is \$28, 60 which must be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust 61 Fund. If the license plate is damaged or worn, it may be 62 replaced at no charge by applying to the department and 63 64 surrendering the current license plate. 65 4.2. In order to retain the efficient administration of 66 the taxes and fees imposed by this chapter, the 80-cent fee increase in the replacement fee imposed by chapter 2009-71, Laws 67 of Florida, is negated as provided in s. 320.0804. 68 69 Section 2.
