**Amendment**

Remove lines 111-120 and insert:

6 code of conduct under s. 1006.07. After determining that the  
 7 student has violated the code of conduct, The the principal  
 8 shall respond either by employing the teacher's recommended  
 9 consequence, or by imposing a more serious disciplinary action,  
 10 if the student's overall behavioral history of disruptive  
 11 behavior warrants it. If the principal determines that a lesser  
 12 disciplinary action other than that recommended by the teacher  
 13 is appropriate, the principal should consult with the teacher  
 14 before prior to taking disciplinary action. If the principal  
 15 determines that the student has not violated the code of  
 16 conduct, the principal shall not impose any discipline. The

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17 principal shall notify the teacher of any decision regarding  
18 discipline, or lack thereof, and interventions provided to a  
19 student to address the behavior. If the principal deviates in  
20 any way from the teacher's recommendation, the principal shall  
21 provide the reasons for any such deviation in writing to the  
22 teacher.
