A bill to be entitled

An act relating to organ donation; providing a short title; amending s. 395.2050, F.S.; requiring the Department of Health to adopt rules to streamline medical testing and transfer medical records for certain entities; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, Nancy Whited suffered from polycystic kidney disease and scleroderma, her declining kidney function required her to have kidney dialysis and eventually a kidney transplant, and

WHEREAS, unfortunately Nancy was removed from the kidney transplant list due to complications from an error in a prescribed medication that affected her bone marrow, and

WHEREAS, despite her reluctance to ask, several individuals stepped forward as live donor candidates for Nancy, leaving two candidates as perfect matches, and

WHEREAS, as one donor seemingly became lost in the paperwork process, the other donors moved further in the process; however, it took nine months to get the tests scheduled, and

WHEREAS, Nancy Whited went in for the transplant procedure but her cardiac function had decreased so significantly that the procedure caused her to go into heart failure which eventually ended her life, and
