A bill to be entitled

An act relating to deepwater port dredging; amending s. 403.816, F.S.; directing the Department of Environmental Protection to require a specified analysis as a condition of permits issued for maintenance dredging of deepwater ports; providing requirements for conducting the analysis; requiring a local government to provide notice of its intent to conduct such analysis to certain local governments; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsection (3) of section 403.816, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (4), and a new subsection (3) is added to that section to read:

403.816 Permits for maintenance dredging of deepwater ports and beach restoration projects.—

dredging of deepwater ports pursuant to this section, the department shall require a habitat equivalency analysis to determine the adverse impacts of the dredging activity on the natural habitat. The analysis must be conducted by an independent contractor selected by the local government in a manner prescribed by the department. The independent contractor for the analysis may not be associated with any project of the contractor performing the dredging activity for the local government. The local government shall provide written notice of its intent to conduct a habitat equivalency analysis to adjacent
