Section 1. Section 106.1405, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

12 106.1405 Use of campaign funds.—

- (1) A candidate or the spouse of a candidate may not use funds on deposit in a campaign account of such candidate to defray normal living expenses for the candidate or the candidate's family, other than expenses actually incurred for transportation, meals, and lodging by the candidate or a family member during travel in the course of the campaign.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a candidate may use funds on deposit in his or her campaign account to pay for child care expenses while the candidate is engaging in campaign activities if such expenses would not have been incurred in the absence of the campaign.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
