A bill to be entitled

An act relating to lottery retailer compensation; amending s. 24.105, F.S.; requiring that specified compensation be paid to retailers for Florida Lottery ticket sales; deleting a limitation on additional retailer compensation; repealing s. 58, chapter 2022-157, Laws of Florida, relating to the future expiration of an amendment; providing effective dates.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (i) of subsection (9) of section 24.105, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

24.105 Powers and duties of department.—The department shall:

- (9) Adopt rules governing the establishment and operation of the state lottery, including:
- (i) The manner and amount of compensation of retailers, provided, however, that except for the 2022-2023 fiscal year only, effective July 1, 2022, the commission for Florida Lottery ticket sales shall be 6 5.75 percent of the purchase price of each ticket sold or issued as a prize by a retailer. Any additional retailer compensation is limited to the Florida Lottery Retailer Bonus Commission program appropriated in Specific Appropriation 2759U of the 2022-2023 General Appropriations Act.
- Section 2. Effective upon this act becoming a law, section 58 of chapter 2022-157, Laws of Florida, is repealed.
  - Section 3. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this
