403.867 License required.—A person may not perform the duties of an operator of a water treatment plant, water distribution system, or a domestic wastewater treatment plant unless he or she holds an active and valid operator a current operator's license issued by the department under s. 403.872 or s. 403.8721.

Section 3. Section 403.8721, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

403.8721 Requirements for licensure by reciprocity.-

- (1) The department shall issue a license by reciprocity to any applicant who at a minimum:
- (a) Is a water treatment plant operator, water distribution system operator, or domestic wastewater treatment plant operator and holds an active and valid license from another state, the federal government, a territory or tribal government that has been designated as the primary agency by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, or any unit thereof for which the licensure requirements, including

Has performed duties comparable to a water treatment plant operator, water distribution system operator, or domestic wastewater treatment plant operator while serving in the United States Armed Forces for which the requirements for performing the duties, including education and operational experience, are comparable to or exceed the licensure requirements of s. 403.872.
- 2. Has passed a skill assessment or competency examination comparable to the licensure examination of the department, subject to approval by the department.
- 3. Is not the subject of a disciplinary or enforcement action at the time of application for reciprocal licensure.
