A bill to be entitled

An act relating to flood zone disclosures for dwelling units; creating s. 83.505, F.S.; requiring landlords or persons authorized to enter into rental agreements on behalf of landlords to make specified disclosures relating to flood zones before the commencement of a tenancy; requiring landlords to notify current tenants of a change in a dwelling unit's flood zone designation; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 83.505, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

83.505 Disclosure of flood zone.—A landlord, or a person

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authorized to enter into a rental agreement on the landlord's behalf, must disclose in writing to a tenant before the commencement of a tenancy whether the dwelling unit is located within a flood zone established by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. If the dwelling unit is located within a flood zone, such disclosure must also include the risk

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designation for the flood zone and definition of the designation as determined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. If the flood zone designation of a dwelling unit changes, a landlord

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must notify the current tenants in writing or by e-mail of the
