Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 364.10, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

364.10 Lifeline service.-

- (1) (a) An eligible telecommunications carrier shall provide a Lifeline Assistance Plan to qualified residential subscribers, as defined in the eligible telecommunications carrier's published schedules. For the purposes of this section, the term "eligible telecommunications carrier":
- $\underline{1}$. Means a telecommunications company, as defined by s. 364.02, which is designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier by the commission pursuant to 47 C.F.R. s. 54.201; and
- 2. Notwithstanding the provision of s. 364.011 which exempts certain commercial mobile radio service providers from commission oversight, includes any commercial mobile radio service provider designated by the commission pursuant to 47

C.F.R. s. 54.201. The commission, upon petition, may make such a designation for the limited purpose of providing Lifeline service.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
