



26        (2) The person responsible for the operation of the  
 27 facility housing each district court of appeal may use state-  
 28 appropriated funds or private funding to provide a lactation  
 29 space as set forth in subsection (1).

30        (3) The requirements of subsection (1) do not apply to a  
 31 courthouse if the person who is responsible for the operation of  
 32 the courthouse determines that:

33            (a) New construction would be required to create the  
 34 lactation space; and

35            (b) The courthouse does not contain a lactation space for  
 36 employees which may be used by the members of the public and the  
 37 courthouse does not have:

38                1. A space that could be repurposed as a lactation space  
 39 open to the public; or

40                2. A space that could be made private at a reasonable cost  
 41 using portable materials, contingent upon private funding being  
 42 made available for those costs.

43        Section 2. The Legislature finds that this act fulfills an  
 44 important state interest.

45        Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
