14	appearing on the ballot shall be determined by the Department of
15	State. The names of candidates for election to each nonpartisan
16	office shall be listed in alphabetical order. With respect to
17	retention of justices and judges, the question "Shall Justice
18	(or Judge) (name of justice or judge) <mark>,</mark> appointed by Governor
19	(name of Governor who appointed the justice or judge, if
20	applicable), of the (name of the court) be retained in office?"
21	shall appear on the ballot in alphabetical order and thereafter
22	the words "Yes" and "No."
23	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
