(1) A court may contract with a third-party translation service provider for translation services for civil cases.

(3) Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a party from providing for his or her own translation service or third-party translation service provider.

(4) The provision of translation services under this section is an optional court-related function, and nothing in this section requires a court to provide such services.
