### SB 702 (SO) by Senator Simmons—

Florida Statutes; Deleting provisions that have expired, have become obsolete, have had their effect, have served their purpose, or have been impliedly repealed or superseded; replacing incorrect crossreferences and citations; correcting grammatical, typographical, and like errors; removing inconsistencies, redundancies, and unnecessary repetition in the statutes; improving the clarity of the statutes and facilitating their correct interpretation; and confirming the restoration of provisions unintentionally omitted from republication in the acts of the Legislature during the amendatory process, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act shall take effect on the 60th day after adjournment sine die of the session of the Legislature in which enacted

### SB 704 (SO) by Senator Simmons—

**Florida Statutes;** Repealing and amending provisions to delete provisions which have become inoperative by noncurrent repeal or expiration and, pursuant to s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i), F.S., may be omitted from the 2015 Florida Statutes only through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the Legislature, etc. Effective Date: On the 60th day after adjournment sine die of the session of the Legislature in which enacted

### SB 706 (SO) by Senator Simmons-

Florida Statutes; Amending provisions and repealing provisions to conform to the directive of the Legislature in section 9 of chapter 2012-116, Laws of Florida, codified as section 11.242(5)(j), Florida Statutes, to prepare a reviser's bill to omit all statutes and laws, or parts thereof, which grant duplicative, redundant, or unused rulemaking authority, etc. Effective Date: On the 60th day after adjournment sine die of the session of the Legislature in which enacted

## CS/SB 426 (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Gaetz—

#### CS/SB 132 (2R1) by the Committee on Transportation, Senator Joyner and others—

**Disabled Parking Permits;** Authorizing certain veterans to provide the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles alternative documentation for renewal or replacement of a disabled parking permit, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2015

Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation; and the Committee on Fiscal Policy reports the committee substitute favorably
