#### BILLS ON THIRD READING

# HB 7109, 1st Eng. (3R) by the Committee on Ways and Means Committee, Representative Boyd and others—

**Taxation;** Deletes application & renewal fees for certain licenses; deletes specified cigarette taxes from being deposited in certain trust fund for biomedical purposes; reduces tax levied on renting, leasing, letting, or granting of license for use of real property; authorizes refunds or credits of taxes paid on certain admissions; provides additional sales tax exemptions for certain agricultural products; extends expiration date of community contribution tax credit program; provides sales tax exemptions for retail sale of certain clothing, school supplies, personal computers, personal computer-related accessories; disaster preparedness supplies, & educational textbooks & instructional materials during specified periods; provides repeal dates & appropriations. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Appropriations
