BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

BILLS ON THIRD READING

SB 8-A, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Bradley and others—

Medical Use of Marijuana; Providing an exemption from the state tax on sales, use, and other transactions for marijuana and marijuana delivery devices used for medical purposes; providing qualifying medical conditions for a patient to be eligible to receive marijuana or a marijuana delivery device; providing for the establishment of medical marijuana testing laboratories; establishing the Coalition for Medical Marijuana Research and Education within the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, Inc., etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Read the second time and amended on June 8, 2017

SB 6-A (3R) by Senator Bradley and others—

Public Records/Medical Marijuana Use Registry/Physician Certification for Marijuana and Dispensing/Department of Health; Exempting from public records requirements personal identifying information of patients, caregivers, and physicians held by the Department of Health in the medical marijuana use registry and personal identifying information related to the physician certification for marijuana and the dispensing thereof held by the department; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 8A or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law

SB 2500-A, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Latvala—

Supplemental Appropriations; Providing moneys for the annual period beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, to fund the Florida Education Finance Program, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2017; or, if this act fails to become a law until after that date, it shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2017

Read the second time and amended on June 8, 2017

SB 2502-A, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Latvala—

Implementing SB 2500-A, an Act Making Supplemental Appropriations to Fund the Florida Education Finance Program for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year; Authorizing the distribution of funds for the Florida Education Finance Program pursuant to any law providing funding for the 2017-2018 fiscal year; providing for construction of the act in pari materia with laws enacted during the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2017; or, if this act fails to become a law until after that date, it shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2017

Read the second time and amended on June 8, 2017

SB 2-A, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Latvala—

Economic Programs; Creating the Florida Job Growth Grant Fund within the Department of Economic Opportunity; providing eligibility criteria for projects to receive funds from the Florida Job Growth Grant Fund; requiring the Department of Economic Opportunity to retain state funds for specified programs in the State Economic Enhancement and Development Trust Fund until certain conditions are met; creating the Targeted Marketing Assistance Program to enhance the tourism business marketing of small, minority, rural, and agritourism businesses in the state; terminating the Displaced Homemaker Trust Fund within the Department of Economic Opportunity, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

Read the second time and amended on June 8, 2017

SB 4-A, 1st Eng. (3R) by Senator Flores—

Supplemental Appropriations for Medicaid Hospital Programs; Providing moneys for the annual period beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, to fund the state Medicaid program; incorporating by reference certain calculations of the Medicaid Disproportionate Share Hospital and Hospital Reimbursement programs, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2017; or, if this act fails to become a law until after that date, it shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2017

Read the second time and amended on June 8, 2017

SENATE BILLS FILED

SB 12-A

School District Capital Outlay Funding; Increasing the millage school boards are authorized to levy for school purposes upon a specified vote; providing requirements for the distribution of such funds to charter schools; conforming a provision to changes made by the act; providing for construction of the act in pari materia with laws enacted during the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature, etc. EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2017, or upon becoming a law, whichever occurs later.
