## SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### **CS/CS/SB 98 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Judiciary, Senator Steube and others—**

**Health Insurer Authorization;** Prohibiting prior authorization forms from requiring certain information; requiring health insurers and pharmacy benefits managers on behalf of health insurers to provide certain information relating to prior authorization by specified means; requiring health insurers to publish on their websites and provide to insureds in writing a procedure for insureds and health care providers to request protocol exceptions, etc. Effective Date: 01/01/2019

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 100 (2R) by Senator Steube—**

**Identification Card and Driver License Fees for Veterans;** Deleting fees for adding the word "Veteran" to an identification card or a driver license; revising acceptable forms of identification required to add the word "Veteran" to an identification card or a driver license; prohibiting tax collectors from charging certain driver license service fees to veterans who present specified forms of identification, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

### **CS/CS/SB 140 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Judiciary, Senator Benacquisto and others—**

**Marriage Licenses;** Providing that a marriage license may not be issued to a person under the age of 18 years; requiring parties to a marriage to file a written and signed affidavit with the county court judge or clerk of the circuit court before the judge or clerk may issue a marriage license; requiring each party to a marriage to provide his or her social security number or an alien registration number for purposes of child support enforcement; clarifying that a county court judge or clerk of a circuit court commits a misdemeanor if he or she issues a blank marriage license or if he or she issues a marriage license without obtaining the ages and identification numbers of the parties, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary; the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs reports the committee substitute favorably; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 146 (2R) by Senator Bean and others—**

**Appointment of Attorneys for Dependent Children with Special Needs;** Designating this act as the "Pro Bono Matters Act of 2018"; requiring the payment of due process costs of litigation of all pro bono attorneys appointed to represent dependent children with certain special needs, subject to appropriations and review for reasonableness, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

### **SCR 184 (2R) by Senator Thurston and others—**

**Joint Committee on the Library of Congress/Statue Replacement Approval;** Requesting the Joint Committee on the Library of Congress to approve the replacement of the statue of Confederate General Edmund Kirby Smith in the National Statuary Hall Collection with a statue of Mary McLeod Bethune, etc.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 186 (2R) by Senator Hutson—**

**Resign-to-run Law;** Requiring an officer who qualifies for federal public office to resign from the office he or she presently holds if the terms, or any part thereof, run concurrently; prescribing requirements for the written resignation; providing for an automatic irrevocable resignation in the event of noncompliance, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Ethics and Elections; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 192 (2R) by Senator Baxley—**

**Public Meetings;** Specifying conditions under which members of any board or commission of any state agency or authority or of any agency or authority of any county, municipal corporation, or political subdivision may participate in fact-finding exercises or excursions, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Ethics and Elections; reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 220 (2R) by Senator Passidomo—**

**Bankruptcy Matters in Foreclosure Proceedings;** Authorizing lienholders to use certain documents as an admission in an action to foreclose a mortgage; providing that submission of certain documents in a foreclosure action creates a rebuttable presumption that the defendant has waived any defenses to the foreclosure; requiring a court to take judicial notice of orders entered in bankruptcy cases under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

### **CS/SB 330 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Gainer—**

**Transportation Facility Designations/Lieutenant Ewart T. Sconiers Highway;** Providing an honorary designation of a certain transportation facility in a specified county, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Transportation; recommended favorably as a committee substitute by Appropriations Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/SB 370 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations, Senator Bradley and others—**

**Land Acquisition Trust Fund;** Requiring a specified annual appropriation to the Florida Forever Trust Fund; prohibiting moneys from the Land Acquisition Trust Fund from being used for specified costs, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on the Environment and Natural Resources; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**SB 404 (2R) by Senator Grimsley and others—**

**State Symbols;** Abrogating the scheduled repeal of the state saltwater reptile designation; abrogating the scheduled repeal of the state horse designation; designating the Florida Cracker Cattle as the official state heritage cattle breed, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 472 (2R) by Senator Thurston and others—**

**National Statuary Hall;** Requesting the Joint Committee on the Library of Congress to approve the replacement of the statue of Confederate General Edmund Kirby Smith in the National Statuary Hall Collection with a statue of Mary McLeod Bethune; providing that the act is an official request to the Joint Committee on the Library of Congress, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 494 (2R) by Senator Lee—**

**Linear Facilities;** Revising the definition of the term “development” to exclude work by certain utility providers on utility infrastructure on certain rights-of-way or corridors; requiring the consideration of a certain variance standard when including conditions for the certification of an electrical power plant; clarifying that the Public Service Commission has exclusive jurisdiction to require underground transmission lines, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities; and reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs*

**CS/CS/SB 568 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Commerce and Tourism and Senator Young—**

**Telephone Solicitation;** Revising the definition of the term “telephonic sales call” to include voicemail transmissions; prohibiting the transmission of voicemails to specified persons who communicate to a telephone solicitor that they would not like to receive certain voicemail solicitations or requests for donations, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

**SB 7000 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice (Bracy)—**

**OGSR/Criminal History Records/Department of Law Enforcement;** Amending provisions relating to an exemption from public records requirements for certain criminal history records ordered expunged which are retained by the Department of Law Enforcement; saving the exemption from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

**SB 7002 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice (Bracy)—**

**OGSR/Active Criminal Intelligence or Criminal Investigative Information;** Amending provisions which provides an exemption from public meetings requirements for portions of a meeting of a duly constituted criminal justice commission at which active criminal intelligence information or active criminal investigative information being considered by, or which may foreseeably come before, the commission is discussed; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 7004 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary (Steube)—**

**OGSR/Petitioner Information/Notification of Service of an Injunction for Protection;** Amending provisions relating to the exemptions from public records requirements for personal identifying and location information of a petitioner who requests notification of service of an injunction for protection against domestic violence, repeat violence, sexual violence, and dating violence and for other court actions related to the injunction which are held by clerks of the court and law enforcement agencies; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemptions, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2018

**SB 7006 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary (Steube)—**

**OGSR/Investigation of a Violation of the Florida False Claims Act/Department of Legal Affairs;** Amending provisions relating to an exemption from public record requirements for the complaint and information held by the Department of Legal Affairs pursuant to an investigation of a violation of the Florida False Claims Act; abrogating the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2018

**Sale of Firearms;** Requiring Department of Law Enforcement procedures to allow the payment or transmittal of processing fees for criminal history checks of potential firearms buyers by electronic means; providing that criminal history check requests by licensed importers, manufacturers, and dealers to the department may be made by electronic means, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2018

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary; Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice recommends the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

### **CS/SB 204 (2R1) by the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation, Senator Bradley and others—**

**Land Acquisition Trust Fund;** Revising the specified appropriation for spring restoration, protection, and management projects; requiring a specified appropriation for certain projects related to the St. Johns River and its tributaries or the Keystone Heights Lake Region, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation; Appropriations Subcommittee on the Environment and Natural Resources recommends the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

### **SB 232 (2R1) by Senator Book and others—**

**Coral Reefs;** Establishing the Southeast Florida Coral Reef Ecosystem Conservation Area, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on the Environment and Natural Resources; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

### **CS/SB 444 (2R1) by the Committee on Health Policy and Senator Bean—**

**Pregnancy Support Services;** Requiring the Department of Health to contract with a not-for-profit statewide alliance of organizations to provide pregnancy support and wellness services through subcontractors; requiring the contractor to spend a specified percentage of funds on direct client services; specifying the entities eligible for a subcontract, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2018

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Policy; Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services recommends the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*
