1 17	19	<b>INLET MANAGEMENT.</b> Provides that notwithstanding s. 161.143, F.S., which requires DEP to make available at least 10 percent of the total amount appropriated in each fiscal year for statewide beach management for the three highest-ranked projects on the current year's inlet management project list, for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the amount allocated for inlet management funding is provided in the GAA.	Same
2 18	22	<b>LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUND.</b> Amends s. 375.041, F.S. to provide for allocation from the trust fund to be used for Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL) program and provides that funds may be transferred to the Save Our Everglades TF for Everglades restoration and to the Florida Forever Trust Fund for the Florida Forever Program and authorizes nonoperating transfer pursuant to section 216.181(12).  <i>Senate bill:</i> 1. Same language for TMDL program; 2. Does not transfer funds to the Florida Forever program; 3. Provides that money transferred to Save Our Everglades TF shall be used to support Everglades restoration projects included in the final report of the Select Committee on Indian River Lagoon and Lake Okeechobee Basin, dated November 8, 2013.	Senate
3 19	23	<b>WATER MANAGEMENT LANDS TRUST FUND.</b> Amends s. 373.59, F.S. to provide for allocation of moneys from the Water Management Lands TF as follows: 1. An amount necessary to pay debt service on bonds issued before February 1, 2009, by the South Water Management District and the St. Johns Water Management District; 2. \$8 million to be transferred to the General Revenue Fund. 3. Any remaining funds will be provided in accordance with the General Appropriations Act.  <i>Senate bill:</i> Same language as 1. and 2. above. Also provides that \$3 million may be transferred to the Save our Everglades Trust Fund to support Everglades restoration projects included in the final report of the Select Committee on Indian River Lagoon and Lake Okeechobee Basin, dated November 8, 2013.	Senate
4	24	<b>RESTORATION STRATEGIES REGIONAL WATER QUALITY PLAN</b> Provides that in order to implement Specific Appropriation 1627, the recurring \$12 million appropriated from the General Revenue Fund and the recurring \$20 million appropriated from the Water Management Lands Trust Fund to DEP for the Restoration Strategies Regional Water Quality Plan provided in ch. 2013-59, Laws of Florida shall be deposited into the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to support Everglades restoration projects included in the final report of the Select Committee on Indian River Lagoon and Lake Okeechobee Basin, dated November 8, 2013.	Senate
5	25	<b>PETROLEUM RESTORATION PROGRAM.</b> Amends s. 376.30711, F.S., to require: (1) All contracts for providers under the Petroleum Restoration Program be procured through competitive bidding; (2) A statement under oath from all owners, responsible parties, and cleanup contractors and subcontractors, that no compensation, remuneration, or gift, of any kind, directly or indirectly, has been solicited, offered accepted, paid or received in exchange for designation or employment in connection with the cleanup of an eligible site, except for the compensation paid by the department to the contractor for the cleanup; (3) A statement under oath from all cleanup contractors and subcontractors receiving compensation for cleanup of eligible sites that they have never paid, offered or provided any compensation in exchange for being designated or hired to do cleanup work, except for the compensation for the cleanup work; and (4) any owner, responsible party or cleanup contractor or subcontractor who falsely executes either of those statements be prohibited from participating in the Petroleum Restoration Program. 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6	20	26	<b>SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM.</b> Amends s. 403.7095, F.S., relating to the solid waste management grant program to require DEP to award \$3 million of grant funds equally to counties having populations of fewer than 100,000 for waste tire, litter prevention, recycling and education, and general solid waste programs.	Same
7	21		<b>FLORIDA FOREVER TRUST FUND.</b> Amends s. 259.105, F.S. to provide: 1. \$15 million to DACS for acquisition of agricultural lands through perpetual conservation easements and other perpetual less-than-fee techniques (Rural & Family Lands Protection program). 2. Remaining funds for land acquisitions that are for: • less-than-fee interest; • partnerships where state's cost is no more than 50 percent; or • conservation lands needed for military buffering, springs or water resources protection.	Senate
8	22	21	<b>CONSERVATION AND RECREATION LANDS TRUST FUND.</b> Amends s. 259.032, F.S. to provide that moneys in the trust fund may be transferred to the Florida Forever Trust Fund for the Florida Forever program and allows the cash transfer in non-operating authority pursuant to section 216.181 (12).  <i>Senate bill:</i> Provides that funds may be transferred to the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund to support Everglades restoration projects included in the final report of the Select Committee on Indian River Lagoon and Lake Okeechobee Basin, dated November 8, 2013.	Senate
9	23		<b>DACS/MARKET IMPROVEMENTS WORKING CAPITAL TRUST FUND.</b> Amends s. 255.25001, F.S., authorizing the deposit of the proceeds from the sale of the Sanford State Farmer's Market into the Market Improvements Working Capital Trust Fund rather than the General Inspection Trust Fund.	House
10	24	20	<b>FIXED CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS/DEEPWATER HORIZON.</b> Amends 216.181, F.S., to authorize LBC approval of fixed capital outlay appropriations related to the civil and criminal settlement money from the Deepwater Horizon Oil spill. Senate bill specifically names settlements at issue.	Same
11		27	<b>LIONFISH.</b> Provides that Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission may pay a bounty for each lionfish captured and destroyed from state or adjacent federal waters during participating lionfish derbies.	Senate
12			<b>NEW.</b> Authorizes the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to expend funds provided for the fuel fleet vehicle rebate program for participating commercial applicants.	Senate
