TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES WIRELESS SERVICES 2838 SPECIAL CATEGORIES CONTRACTED SERVICES From the funds in Specific Appropriation 2838, \$933,800 of nonrecurring funds from the Law Enforcement Radio System Trust Fund is provided for the Department of Management Services to acquire the necessary staff augmentation support and subject matter experts to assist the department towards developing a proposed competitive solicitation and providing other services as determined necessary by the department for procuring a land mobile radio support system that includes a Project 25 Phase II delivery methodology.	From the funds in Specific Appropriation 2838, \$933,800 of nonrecurring funds from the Law Enforcement Radio System Trust Fund is provided for the Department of Management Services to acquire and maintain the necessary staff augmentation support and subject matter experts to assist the department in the competitive solicitation and providing other services as determined necessary by the department for procuring a land mobile radio support system based upon a Project 25 Phase II delivery methodology. The system will provide communication services for state and local public safety agencies. The procurement shall accomplish, but not be limited to: improved coverage, audio clarity, interoperability, and enhanced system features including GPS location service, text messaging, and central device management. The scope of the services provided by the staff augmentation support and subject matter experts should include, but not be limited to, assisting the department in completing the following tasks identified in the study referenced in Specific Appropriation 2904A of Chapter 2014-51, Laws of Florida: (1) project planning and management; (2) consultation and providing technical expertise to the department; (3) assist department as requested in the evaluation of responses; and (4) negotiation with procurement respondents as requested by the department. Additionally, staff augmentation and subject matter experts shall consult with the Joint Task Force on State Agency Law Enforcement Communications and the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles in its capacity as the designated Point of Contact to the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) and as chair of the FloridaNet Executive Committee in order to evaluate any additional technical options to support the voice and data communication requirements of public safety personnel in Florida.
