A comprehensive plan will allow the Village to plan, construct, proactively maintain and improve its stormwater

infrastructure which directly benefits the residents in and around the Village. c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved stormwater management including reduced flooding.

The target population served by this project is the whole community as this project will address drainage and flood reduction as well as individuals passing through our municipality.

- -This project will improve transportation conditions by providing roads free of flooding during or after rain events by facilitating individual mobility. It will improve safety. These can be measured by conducting visual inspections and record keeping.
- -This will also improve the water quality for the C-8 canal and the Biscayne Bay aquifer through better stormwater management bringing better surface water quality. These can be measured by collecting field data, sampling the water and analyzing the water collected.
