Sarasota County has received approximately \$222.8 million dollars of COVID-19 relief funding through the CARES Act, CRRSA, and ARPA. Funding was and is currently being used to respond to the short and long term impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, to include financially supporting impacted local businesses, individuals, non-profits, and municipal partners through the completed Sarasota CARES program; providing emergency rental assistance to landlords and tenants through the Sarasota ERA program; and advancing affordable housing efforts, water quality projects, recovering revenue loss, and supporting other miscellaneous capital projects through the Sarasota SLFRF program.

A new connection between the Gulf of Mexico and Little Sarasota Bay is expected to improve water quality, increase economic and tourism activity in this part of Sarasota County with increased boating, related retail/commercial activities and property values.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All of Sarasota County and any visitors to the Little Sarasota Bay area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project is intended to improve water quality within Little Sarasota Bay and increase the population of fisheries, shellfish and seagrasses. A new connection between the Gulf of Mexico and Little Sarasota Bay is expected to improve water quality, increase economic and tourism activity in this part of Sarasota County with increased boating, related retail/commercial activities and property values.

Outcomes will measured through environmental sampling and statistics and annual seagrass monitoring/measurements, along with tax receipts, permit applications, property appraiser valuations and Chamber of Commerce statistics.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Sarasota County imposes performance reporting for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in its consulting contracts. In severe cases of failure, consultants may be placed on a no-bid prohibition for County related contracting.
