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The Italian Club building, a registered historic landmark, and the oldest Italian organization of its type in the United States (ref: Tony Pizzo), organized April 4th, 1894, is in need of further preservation work in order to maintain its mission within the community. One of the major aspects of this request is to bring the building up to current code, but also looking into the future as it pertains to modernization and energy efficiency of the facility.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Continued success within the community as it pertains to membership, cultural enrichment activities and events, as well as community outreach programs and support of other nonprofit organizations

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Italian Club of Tampa is a historical landmark open daily for tours, as well as open for community and cultural events. The club regularly hosts language classes, cooking classes, culturally specific events, historical presentations, etc. The club will work closely with local 501c3's who utilize the club to host events that better the community through their own endeavors.
