4. Project/Program Description

AMIkids, Inc. envisions the development of a kids-first, trauma-responsive campus to serve the ongoing and varied needs of the youth, young adults, and families that seek out our effective services each year. The AMIkids Center for Personal Growth would represent an innovative program solution that houses workforce development and training, family centric counseling and support, individualized education, experiential learning, comprehensive behavioral health services, and consolidated program administration in one centralized location to better respond to the needs of Florida families. The first phase in realizing this ambition is commissioning a year-long feasibility study to identify a suitable property, develop facility plans, and establish a phased construction timeline. AMIkids, Inc. requests \$250,000 to conduct the initial feasibility study.

Four AMIkids programs that currently receive state funding received a total of \$1.6M in PPP. The funds were used to retain staff while incurring a reduction in school board and treatment funding. In addition, in order to best protect youth from COVID-19 & prevent outbreaks at our facilities, COVID funding was used for PPE, facility cleanings, and additional expenses, including staff overtime, incurred when youth quarantine or alternative services were necessary. All PPP loans have been forgiven.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding from this request will enable AMIkids to hire a consultant to perform a feasibility study. AMIkids would like to develop a trauma-responsive campus to serve youth, families and staff in Florida. Prior to embarking on this endeavor, we wish to engage the professional services of an expert to guide us through building considerations, including location, costs, and timelines.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

AMIkids will hire a consultant to perform the feasibility study and produce a list of recommendations by the end of the funding year.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

We envision collecting stakeholder feedback (from youth, families, and community partners) during the feasibility study to help inform the consultant's recommendations. The facility that results from this study will directly serve citizens across Florida.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

While the feasibility study will not directly serve constituents, the trauma-responsive campus will serve youth ages 11-24 and their families. We expect the feasibility study will inform us how many individuals can safely be served at one time, given space and resource considerations.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Youth, families and team members throughout Florida will have a trauma-responsive campus that empowers youth and families through workforce development and training in high-demand industries; on-site counseling and family services; individualized education offerings for youth needing non-traditional educational supports; and experiential learning opportunities.
