The deep bed sand filter is a critical component of the treatment process and provides several essential purposes, including the removal of suspended solids, turbidity reduction, and nutrient removal. The filter is over 25 years old and the valves, pumps, and other components within the filters have deteriorated and need to be replaced. This project is one part of the full approximately \$80,000,000 plant upgrade the City is preparing to fund and is for the complete mechanical and electrical rehabilitation.

Construction activities associated with the rehabilitation of the filter, along with engineering and inspection services to insure the project is constructed in conformance with the design documents.
