4. Project/Program Description

In Palm Beach County, eligible customers may qualify for a discounted fixed route bus pass if they meet household income guidelines that fall between at 150% of the Federal Poverty Level or below. Depending on their income, the customer qualifies to purchase the monthly pass for unlimited trips for \$15 or \$20 instead of the full price of \$70 per pass. This program will allow qualified applicants access to the unlimited pass, drastically increasing their mobility and ability to access employment, medical, and community services.

Palm Beach County is the recipient of CARES US Treasury funds in the amount of \$261 million. Funding was spent entirely on emergency assistance, mortgage assistance, business grants, COVID-19 sheltering, testing and isolation, as well as on emergency personnel. Palm Beach County also received approximately \$290 million in American Rescue Plan Funding for pandemic-related service and infrastructure projects.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The goal of securing funds is to improve transportation options for the low-income, elderly, and disabled residents of Palm Beach County. Through reliable transportation residents are given the opportunity for economic mobility and to access important services in the community. The discounted bus pass program provides an affordable alternative to vehicle ownership which has become more important due to the current economic downturn. These passes encourage paratransit riders to also utilize fixed route services thus increasing efficiency across the entire public transit system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding would enable the distribution of monthly bus passes at a reduced rate of \$15-\$20, as opposed to the standard \$70 for 31 days of unlimited fixed route travel. This pass would provide residents with direct access to transportation via 30+ fixed routes across Palm Beach County.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Funding would enable the distribution of monthly bus passes at a reduced rate of \$15-\$20, as opposed to the standard \$70 for 31 days of unlimited fixed route travel. This pass would provide residents with direct access to transportation via 30+ fixed routes across Palm Beach County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Economically disadvantaged individuals in Palm Beach County seeking transportation. Currently, around 7,000 residents utilize the discounted bus pass, but eligible applicants exceed that number.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Palm Tran tracks the number of individuals served under the program and number of passes sold. The measure of benefit will be the number of trips taken by participants in the programs and savings realized by having access to the pass. The annual review for re-certification will be the best measure of success. Individuals will go from the \$15 to the \$20 program and eventually no longer qualify due to increased income.

Funding should be curtailed from the agency if funds are not used in whole.
