CS/SB 278 (SO) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Senator Martin—

Estoppel Certificates; Prohibiting agreements that indemnify a community association manager or community association management firm for errors or omissions relating to the provision or preparation of an estoppel certificate; revising acts that constitute grounds for which certain disciplinary actions may be taken to include specified actions relating to estoppel certificates; revising the time in which a community association must provide an estoppel certificate to a requestor, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2024

CS/SB 280 (SO) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Senator DiCeglie—

Vacation Rentals; Requiring advertising platforms to collect and remit specified taxes for certain vacation rental transactions; defining the term "advertising platform"; adding licensing to the regulated activities of public lodging establishments and public food service establishments which are preempted to the state; requiring advertising platforms to require that persons placing advertisements or listings for vacation rentals include certain information in the advertisements or listings and attest to certain information; authorizing the division to revoke, refuse to issue or renew, or suspend vacation rental licenses under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2024

SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

CS/SB 298 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy, Senator Polsky and others—

Local Government Coastal Protections; Providing that only coastal counties and coastal municipalities that received written authorization from the Department of Environmental Protection on or before a specified date may establish construction zoning and building code exceptions to coastal construction control lines; authorizing the department to provide coastal counties, beginning on a specified date, with Resilient Florida Grant Program grants to fund saltwater intrusion vulnerability assessments, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

CS/SB 7014 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, and Ethics and Elections (Burgess)—

Ethics; Increasing the maximum fine for violations of specified lobbying provisions; prohibiting a member of the Commission on Ethics from serving more than two full terms, instead of two full terms in succession; requiring the commission to submit a copy of a certain referral to an alleged violator within a specified timeframe; providing that persons are deemed to waive their rights to a formal or an informal hearing if the request is not received within a specified timeframe, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2024
