Legislative Updates

- **SB 1370:** authorizes veterinarians to practice telemedicine. Passed the Agriculture Committee on 3/17.
- **SB 430:** preempting the regulation of petroleum fuel measuring devices to the state and the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Passed Transportation on 3/16.
- **SB 900:** expands the list of entities that have access to child abuse records. Passed Children, Family & Elder Affairs on 3/16.
- **SB 614:** Providing enhanced criminal penalties for persons who knowingly commit assault or battery upon hospital personnel. Passed Health Policy on 3/16.
- **SB 1606:** requiring the Legislature to annually observe a moment of silence in observance of the victims of communism. Passed Community Affairs on 3/16.
- **SB 1898:** Revising and providing duties for the Just Read, Florida! Office within the Department of Education. Passed Education on 3/16.
- **SB 1450:** offers a revision to Florida's high school civics curriculum. Passed the Appropriations Subcommittee on Education on 3/17.

- **SB 1208:** updates current legislative intent for the Property Assessed Clean Energy Program. Passed Finance and Tax on 3/18.
- **SB 1752:** Improves the maintenance of our sewer systems to better our water quality and protect our resources. Passed Environment & Natural Resources on 3/15!
- **SB 56:** requires condominium associations to maintain specified affirmative acknowledgements of official records. Read on the Senate Floor on 3/18!
- **SB 348:** revises types of emergency transportation vehicle services provided to Medicaid recipients shall pay deductibles and coinsurance. Read on the Senate Floor on 3/18!
- **SB 58:** repeals provision relating to reporting of community benefit expenses. Passed the Senate floor on 3/18!





COVID-19 Vaccine Update:

Effective 3/15/2021, all Seniors 60+ are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at any of the over 1,000 vaccination sites in Florida.

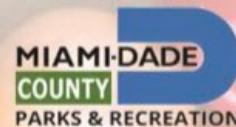
