4. Project/Program Description

The Estero Phase 2 Septic to Sewer Project will extend municipal sewer services several areas of Estero and remove the existing septic tanks and package waste water treatment plants. Removing the septic tanks and treatment plants will eliminate a source of bacteria and nutrients to the Estero River and Estero Bay (Florida first aquatic preserve). The project will improve the quality of water in the Estero River and Estero Bay which will improve the environment and protect human health.

The will also extend municipal drinking water to several areas of Estero. This will provide a better quality and more reliable source of drinking water to residents and reduce the impacts the existing wells have on groundwater and surface water. It will also improve fire protection by providing fire hydrants in an area that currently does not have any fire hydrants.

14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the funds request is to improve the quality of water in the Estero River, Estero Bay and Estero Bay Aquatic Preserve and reduce the potential for drinking water contamination. The Estero Bay has been identified as impaired for nutrients and the Estero River has been identified as impaired for bacteria. Septic Tanks & package waste water treatment plants have been identified as sources of both within the watershed. Removing septic tanks and treatment plants will reduce the nutrient and bacteria load to the River and Bay helping to improve water quality and reduce the impairments.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will remove septic tanks and package waste water treatment plants from properties within Estero that drain to the Estero River/Estero Bay. Removing the septic tanks/treatment plants and sending the wastewater to a wastewater treatment plant will eliminate a source of nutrient and bacteria pollution to the Estero River/Estero Bay.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will see improved water quality in the Estero River and Estero Bay. Citizens in the project area will be provided central potable water and sewer which are safer, and more reliable environmentally sound sources.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population serviced by this project are the residents along Broadway Ave. and all residents and visitors to Lee County

The improved water quality in the Estero River and Estero Bay will serve all residents in Estero, City of Bonita Springs, Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit from the project is improve quality of water in the Estero River and Estero Bay and improve reliability of water and wastewater services to residents.

The outcome will be measured by continuing to monitor the quality of water in the Estero River and Estero Bay.

The project construction bid documents will require a bond to cover the bid amount to ensure the contractor completes the project. The Village proposes to include liquidated damages in the project's construction contract.
