a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Businesses and residential housing units located in the eastern section of Town of Hilliard will have sufficient water volume and pressure for every day use and when needed to fight fires within the community.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The looping of the existing potable water system serving the businesses and residential housing units located in the eastern section of the Town of Hilliard.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will improve the quality of life for citizen living in the eastern part of the Town of Hilliard by increasing the dependency, pressure and volume of the central water system serving the eastern portion of the Town. The increased water pressure and volume will improve the quality of life for the citizens living in the eastern part of the Town of Hilliard.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for the project are the people living in the eastern part of the Town of Hilliard. It is estimated the eastern part of the Town of Hilliard contains approximately 500 people, all of whom will benefit from the improvements to the potable water distribution system serving the area being fully looped.

This project will improve the quality of life for the citizen living in the eastern part of the Town of Hilliard by increasing the dependency, pressure and volume of the central water system serving the area. The increased water pressure volume and reliability will improve the quality of life for the citizens living in the east Hilliard area.
