a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested will be used for: (1) designing and developing an interactive learning platform with advanced accessibility to all kinds of learners; (2) designing and developing the SIMPACT immersive learning experience feature; (3) expanding the workforce to cover all kinds of growing operational needs; (4) future fundraising activities; (5) compensating the consultancy / studies / tests services used and needed; (6) collection of data; and (7) program evaluation.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The organization aims to provide education and resources to all parents with special needs children. To meet this goal, PESC will build a learner platform with a comprehensive curriculum that is also reachable by all types of audiences; PESC will also run studies with local researchers / universities to assess the outcomes / efficacies of such platform.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The organization will provide parents education stabilization courses specifically tailored to parents with kids with special needs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Persons with poor mental health, Persons with poor physical health, At-risk youth, Developmentally or Physically Disabled individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Education provided in the course will enrich the family unit and improve life outcomes for coparents and children. With increased knowledge and skills participants will:

- 1. Encourage learning and education in their children
- 2. Set high and realistic expectations, standards and goals for their children
- 3. Become involved in school and community activities

Parents can learn to share responsibility for the children and improve care for a disabled child. This in turn can improve outcomes.

Methodology: Pre and Post Perception surveys (attitudinal data); Empathy Interviews (Focus group)

As a result of taking this course, participants will: (1) Pay attention to and respect their own feelings; (2) Use empathy as a tool to better be able to connect with others; (3) Experience less toxic emotions (anger, jealousy, resentment); and (4) Practice empathy.
