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Activities include seeking contractual architectural services for design-build of Sheriff administration offices through the County procurement policies and procedures.

Direct services is a centrally located, hardened, facility to better serve the citizenry in this financially disadvantaged community that is located in a Rural Area of Economic Opportunity to effectively & efficiently perform operations and administration that will house the patrol, investigation, civil, warrants divisions, sufficient conference area & evidence storage facility.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is citizenry, visitors and residents of Glades County, which is a financially disadvantaged community, located in a Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern. Greater than 12,000 to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit is a centrally located facility with the appropriate space to house the Sheriff administration services that will protect the general public from harm as operations will be done efficiently and effectively. Completion and certification of the project.
