Funds will be used to accomplish the first necessary step of preparing 120 acres of land that will ultimately be open to the public as outdoor recreation space.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will be used for the design and permitting of the site remediation process concerning a landfill on the property. Bobby Jones Nature Park is part of a larger project encompassing wetlands creation and a golf course, spanning 280 acres of land which recently became a Protected Property through a Conservation Easement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

These funds will not be used for direct services to citizens but citizens will directly benefit from the final outcome of the project (a new nature park on land where a conservation easement has been approved to preserve the greenspace in perpetuity).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will ultimately serve the general public. Because the property is now a Protected Property through the Conservation Easement, it will be open to the public as outdoor recreation space in perpetuity. There are over 50,000 people in the City of Sarasota and over 400,000 people in Sarasota County, in which the City is situated.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

For this Phase of the project, the expected outcome is having the deliverables necessary to implement the project, such as the design and permitting documents. The Bobby Jones Nature Park cannot progress to Phase II construction without this assistance for Phase I.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures would include: a) a return of funding and, b) a report explaining why the deliverables or performance measures were not met.
