The Town of Surfside has identified the need to replace approximately 5,900 linear feet of 8-inch cast iron (CI) pipe with 12-inch Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC C-900) pipe from the intersection of Harding Avenue and 87th St., then North along Harding Avenue and east along 88th St. to Collins Avenue (SR A1A), and North along Collins Avenue (SR A1A) to 96th St., Surfside, Florida. The project is required to improve water service reliability and replace the existing system reaching its end of service.
