14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Due to a rapid increase in population growth the permitted flow of the Bates Ave Wastewater Treatment Plant has reach 80% of its design capacity. This City must upgrade the Plant to accommodate increased demand, and support continued population growth and development over the next 20 years. Additionally, the City has entered into an agreement to take all of the wastewater flow from the City of Umatilla.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The Bates Ave WWTP is currently running in excess of 80% of its design capacity of 2.4 MGD. Engineering for a 0.9 MGD expansion was awarded as well as the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) in early 2022. Currently, 90% design plans have been prepared and are being bid by the CMAR Contractor. Preliminary estimates (30% plans) for the full 900,000 gpd expansion.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Modernizing the Bates Street WWTP will allow the City to manage more wastewater, protect the environment, maintain compliance with all state and federal regulations, and allow greater opportunity for community growth and development.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This City must upgrade the Plant to accommodate increased demand from the Cities of Eustis and Umatilla, and support continued population growth and development over the next 20 years.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Will upgrade move citizens away from septic systems by converting septic tanks systems to central sewer systems that provide nutrient removal technology and advanced wastewater treatment.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The City will pay back the appropriated funds if the project is not completed.
