14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project's goal is to complete the critical improvements and upgrades at the deteriorating NEFSH WTP. The WTP serves the entire City, along with NEFSH and the new Legacy Elementary School. These needed upgrades will result in more reliable pressure/fire flow and allow the City to serve the ongoing and future development at the I-10/SR-121 economic corridor. It will also resolve the WTP violations identified in the recent FDEP inspection, resulting in more efficient, safe, and reliable WTP operations.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The requested funds will be utilized for engineering design, permitting, and construction. The WTP improvements will ensure the intended goals are met, as project completion will provide more efficient, safe, resilient, and reliable water service to the City of Macclenny and NEFSH, as well as increased pressure/fire flow.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens of Macclenny will directly benefit from the completion of the appropriation project by receiving improved and more reliable water pressures and fire flow, along with improved and more consistent water quality.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the approximately 7,600 citizens of the City of Macclenny, citizens in Butler County located within the City's Utility Service Area, local businesses, NEFSH, the new Legacy Elementary School, as well as the future development that is anticipated to occur along the SR-121 commercial corridor.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Project completion will result in a City-wide benefit of a more efficient, resilient, and stable WTP and potable water service, with an additional economic benefit of being able adequately to serve ongoing and future development at the I-10/SR 121 corridor. Improved water pressure and fire flows will be measured via hydrant flow testing. Increased economic activity will be measured by new growth that occurs following the completion of the project once adequate water service is available (see attached Map for projected development). Water quality will be measured via FDEP-required scheduled water testing.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If the City does not complete this project, FDEP will issue an Administrative or Consent Order to the City for the variety of issues at the NEFSH WTP, which were identified as violations by FDEP at their 5-26-22 inspection. The issuance of an AO or CO by FDEP will result in penalties in accordance w/ FSS and FAC. The Warning Letter WL22-176 sent to the City following the inspection is attached. The City was not fully aware of the extent of the issues when they took ownership of the WTP in 2021. The City will assess liquidated damages to the selected Contractor if they do not meet the contractual completion date.
