a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

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The panhandle of Florida, designated at Region 1 in the State Emergency Response Plan, is the only region that does not include an Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Task Force. The goal of this funding is to increase USAR capabilities in this area of our state by providing accessible training its fire service professionals. Once adequate numbers of trained professionals are achieved, fire departments can collaborate to form a USAR Task Force and will not have to rely on outside resources.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Citizens in communities throughout the Panhandle of Florida will be the recipients of emergency response from fire service professionals with a higher level training and capability in technical rescue emergencies.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Services provided to communities throughout the Panhandle will be emergency response from responders highly trained in technical rescue disciplines including high and low angle rope rescue, confined space rescue, vehicle and machinery rescue, trench rescue, and structural collapse rescue.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project will be fire service professionals and the citizens of the communities they protect. This will included hundreds of urban search and rescue responders and thousands of the citizens that they protect.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will benefit the general public by increasing the number of fully trained Urban Search and Rescue responders in an area of our state which is currently the most under resourced as it relates to this type of emergency responders. The level of benefit for this project can be measured by the sum of responders trained at this facility. Although more difficult to measure the greatest benefit will be lives saved.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Fire District may, at any time, without cause, order Bidder in writing to suspend, delay or interrupt the work in whole or in part for such period of time as the Fire District may determine, or to terminate all or a portion of the Contract for the Fire District's convenience. Upon such termination, the Contract Price earned to the date of termination shall be paid to Bidder, but Bidder waives any claim for damages, including loss of profits arising out of or related to the early termination.
