Each classroom door will be fitted with the Legacy Barricade Door Locking System.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

It will provide greater security for all students and staff inside the classroom. It will also create a safer learning environment and may even calm some of the fear and anxiety that students and staff have.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire Suwannee School District, Pre-school through Adult Education.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The school classrooms will now be able to be secured, during and active killer event, providing much greater protection than the door lock alone. If the killer is able to make entry at all, the time to do so will be much greater than a lock alone or in the event, a door that is not locked. That time will save lives.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Legacy Barricades, will provide the Suwannee School District 10% off of the total project cost if the project is not completed on the agreed upon date. If the barricade system is not performing to the satisfaction of the school district Superintendent, upon completion of the project, Legacy Barricades will correct all areas of concern and take a 10% reduction in the project payment.
