The Governor addressed lawmakers with his State of the State speech - and Democrats shared their own rebuttals to the misleading narrative he weaved.

Moments before the Governor took the stage to deliver his State of the State speech, Republican lawmakers filed a <u>6-week abortion ban</u>.

Leader Book released a <u>statement</u> in strong opposition to the bill, saying "If it's a war they want, it's a war they will get".

SB 150: PERMITLESS CARRY

The Permitless Carry bill passed its final Senate committee - Fiscal Policy. It was approved on a 13-6 vote, with 5 Democrats in attendance voting down on the bill.

There were more than 50 who testified or submitted a testimony card during committee - including members from Moms Demand Action. They met with Senators throughout the day to advocate for gun safety legislation.

SB 102: AFFORDABLE HOUSING

One of the first bills to pass off the Senate floor is a priority of Senate President Kathleen Passidomo. It passed with bipartisan support. SB 102: Affordable Housing has been described by Democratic Senators as a good first step in dealing with Florida's affordable housing crisis.





DEMOCRATS WORKING FOR YOU

Here's a glance at some of the bills filed by Senate Democrats that were heard in committee during Week 1:

<u>SB 114</u> Tax Exemption for Diapers & Incontinence Products - Leader Lauren Book - *Creates permanent tax exemptions for diapers & incontinence products*

<u>SB 130</u> Domestic Violence - Senator Lori Berman - *Expands the list of factors a court must consider when determining if shared parental responsibility would be detrimental to a child*

<u>SB 144</u> Lactation Spaces - Senator Lori Berman - *Requires each* county courthouse to have at least 1 dedicated lactation space
<u>SB 164</u> Controlled Substance Testing -Senator Tina Polsky Decriminalizes fentany! test strips

<u>SB 204</u> Task Force on the Monitoring of Children in Out-of-Home Care - Senator Darryl Rouson - *Creates a task force to identify why children go missing while in out-of-home care and to ensure prompt & effective action is taken*

<u>SB 226</u> Support for Dependent Adult Children - Senator Lori Berman - Specifies procedures to effectuating the common law duty of parents to support a dependent adult child

<u>SB 286</u> Legal Instruments - Senator Bobby Powell, Jr. - *Amends laws* relating to foreclosures and assignment of rents

<u>SB 292</u> Healthy Food Financing Initiative Program - Senator Shevrin Jones - *Makes changes to a state program that provides financial assistance for creating grocery stores in underserved & low-income communities*

<u>SB 506</u> Comprehensive Waste Reduction and Recycling Plan - Senator Linda Stewart - Requires the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to develop a comprehensive waste reduction and recycling plan
