- It would dually serve as a COVID and natural disaster emergency shelter for able-bodied and special needs Gadsden County residents and evacuees from other areas during a disaster.

The Boys and Girls Club facility will be located in Quincy, Fla., the largest municipality in Gadsden County, Fla. The City of Quincy has less than 12,000 residents and a 36.4% poverty rate.

School aged children and at risk youth in Gadsden County. 12,000 individuals are expected be served.

Research shows the high-quality after-school programs improve students' educational outcomes, school attendance, and social and emotional learning. Afterschool Alliance, an educational watchdog group, claims that quality after-school programs understand that children and youth in different age groups vary in academic, psychological, and physical activity needs. The State of Florida is known nationally for its school grading system, recreational activities, and sports programs. Based on yearly student test results, the Gadsden County public education system has consistently received a C or lower grade from the Florida Department of Education. Gadsden County must receive this funding to ensure its youth have the education, skills, and support to be successful adults and compete in the workforce.
