a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the project is to eliminate ground water and surface water from being introduced into the sanitary sewer collection system. The reduced inflow and infiltration will reduce the burden of treating large amounts of rain and ground water as municipal waste water and reduce operational costs to the City and the treatment plant accepting the flows. In addition, the existing sanitary sewer will experience a larger capacity to collect and convey wastewater to treatment without the need for upgrades or retrofits for a longer duration.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of the recommended repairs and verification that the repairs are acceptable through CCTV inspections. Updates to the City's asset inventory to track and monitor current conditions and recent work.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The City's municipal waste water collection system will see an improved efficiency at conveying wastewater away to treatment. Sanitary Sewer Overflows will be prevented during wet weather events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the general population of the City of Gulfport, The project focuses on residents located nearest the waterfront district since the majority of defects were detected in that location.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduced quantity of wastewater flow sent to treatment during wet weather events measured at the lift stations and a more consistent quantity of flow throughout the year.
