14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The new high school opened in August 2020 and was paid for by Special Facility Funding. During the construction process, the high school softball complex had to be relocated to an alternate location on campus. No Special Facility Funding was available for relocation. A new field was built and fenced. We need to finish the project to provide ADA restrooms/locker rooms, etc. Liberty County School District does not have the tax base nor the revenue to finish this much needed project to be in compliance with Title 9.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The new softball fieldhouse will be a right to a wrong in a major oversight by the Department of Education in the building of the new Liberty County High School. This facility will now give girls softball an equal facility of the that of the boys. It will provide ADA compliant facilities to students, student athletes, and spectators. The LCHS softball team will have a new facility from which to enjoy the sport of softball that has been highly successful in the past. The team played in the FHSAA state series final four last year.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

ADA compliant facilities and concessions. Currently, the field uses portable bathrooms and a makeshift bathroom constructed from a storage shed for facilities. Concessions, which are a huge part of financial revenue, is limited to can drinks and candy sold from a cooler. There is no covered area for concessions.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Liberty County High School currently has 335 students. All students can utilize the field for physical education classes and competitive play.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase ticket sales and a state championship in 2023. We believe the pride that comes from facilities encourages student athletes to play the game. We see this in college recruitment daily. Getting girls interested in extra-curricular sports keeps them off the street and in the game. Discipline issues are drastically reduced when students are involved in extra-curricular activities like softball.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Liberty will forfeit any and all funding if we do not do what we say we will do with the appropriation request.
